Chapter 649 provides food, plus a Gift-Card to each family.

As of November 1, 2014 we only have two small plastic Wal-Mart bag containing @ 8 cans each, of food to be used to help our Clermont County "Veterans In Need"

There were no local area schools able to provide assistance for our food drive this year.

Heisler Park Bingo (senior citizens) have been the only contributors to our 2014 food drive.

If you have any contacts who may wish to support our food-drive, please contact these persons, so we may once again provide help our vets In Need.
