The extraordinary valor of now-retired Cmd. Sgt. Maj. <u>Bennie Adkins</u> and Spc. <u>Donald Sloat</u>, killed in 1970, were belatedly recognized after a painstaking search of files going back to World War II, says Navy Lt. Cmdr. Nate Christensen, a Pentagon spokesman.

"You served with valor," President Obama said of the recipients at the ceremonies Monday, Sept 15.
"You made us proud. And your service is with us for eternity. So no matter how long it takes,
no matter how many years go by, we'll continue to appreciate your service to the country.
"Both men fought in Vietnam.

- . **Bennie Adkins** was a Green Beret wounded 18 times who killed an estimated 135-175 enemy soldiers during a 38-hour battle in March of 1966.
- . Donald Sloat threw himself on a grenade to save his comrades, sacrificing his life on Jan. 17, 1970.
